SB 715	RELATING TO THE PROCUREMENT CODE. Amends the procurement code to establish a preference for the purchase of agricultural products raised or grown in Hawaii.	WAH/TSG, WAM
SB 718	RELATING TO THE PROCUREMENT CODE. Amends the procurement code to establish a preference for the purchase of flower lei made only with flowers grown in Hawaii.	WAH/TSG, WAM
SB 1052	RELATING TO HAWAIIAN LANGUAGE. Requires that all new and replaced letterheads and documents of the State include both state languages, with the Hawaiian language placed above English translation. Establishes a Hawaiian language interim task force. Appropriates funds.	TSG/WAH, WAM

**Public Folder.** A folder labeled "Public Folder" containing the measures and testimonies for the hearing will be available for shared use by members of the public.


