HB 10 (SSCR1211)	RELATING TO PRESCRIPTION DRUGS. Makes rebate agreements between drug manufacturers and department of human services mandatory. Requires the department to inform health care providers about drug costs for manufacturers with rebate agreements and those without rebate agreements.	HTH, CPH
HB 426 HD2 (SSCR1163)	RELATING TO PSYCHOTROPIC MEDICATION. Allows Advanced Practice Registered Nurses with prescriptive authority under Chapter 457, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to prescribe psychotropic medication under public assistance programs. (HB426 HD2)	HTH/HSP, CPH
HB 1018 HD2, SD1 (SSCR1099)	RELATING TO LIQUOR. Establishes a condominium hotel class of liquor license. (SD1)	TSG/IGM, CPH
HB 1456 HD2, SD1 (SSCR1241)	RELATING TO PSYCHOLOGISTS. Authorizes prescriptive authority for qualified psychologists who practice at a federally qualified health center. (SD1)	HTH, CPH
HB 1628 HD1, SD1 (SSCR1292)	RELATING TO HAWAII MACADAMIA NUT PRODUCT LABELING. Requires products with labels representing that a portion of the macadamia nuts in the package was grown in Hawaii, to specify the percentage of Hawaiian-grown macadamia nuts. Prohibits labeling that incorrectly represents that any of the macadamia nuts contained in the package were grown in Hawaii. (SD1)	WAH, CPH
HB 1641 HD2, SD1 (SSCR1252)	RELATING TO PESTICIDES. Prohibits the sale, solicitation, or receipt of orders for restricted use pesticides to an unlicensed pest control applicator or employee of the applicator. (SD1)	ENE, CPH


Persons wishing to comment should submit their comments in one of the following ways at least 24 hours prior to the decision making.

When faxing, please indicate to which committee the comments are being submitted, the date and time of the hearing, and the number of copies needed for submittal.
