HB 1631 HD2 (HSCR1111)	RELATING TO HIGH TECHNOLOGY BUSINESS INVESTMENT TAX CREDIT. Requires qualified high technology businesses claiming the High Technology Business Investment or Research Tax Credit to file with Department of Taxation an annual survey about employment positions in the State. Provides for penalties. Provides that by claiming the credit the business consents to disclosure of their name. (HB1631 HD2)	EDT, WAM
HB 312 HD2 (HSCR1087)	RELATING TO COMMUNITY-BASED ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT. Appropriates \$ for each year in the 2007-2009 fiscal biennium to provide grants under the Hawaii Community-based Economic Development Technical and Financial Assistance Program. (HB312 HD2)	EDT, WAM
HB 1435 HD1 (HSCR1158)	RELATING TO THE STATE OF HAWAII ENDOWMENT FUND. Allows pledges to be used to meet the match requirements for the fiscal year 2006-2007 appropriation to the State of Hawaii endowment fund. Lapses unexpended or unencumbered appropriated funds on June 30, 2009. (HB1435 HD1)	EDT, WAM
HB 1735 HD2 (HSCR1181)	ESTABLISHING A COMMISSION TO COMMEMORATE THE CONTRIBUTIONS OF HAWAII'S RANCHING COMMUNITY. Establishes the Waiomina centennial celebration commission to commemorate the contributions of Hawaii's ranching community. Appropriates funds (HB1735 HD2).	EDT, WAM
