DECISION MAKING ON THE FOLLOWING MEASURE(S):  
(Deferred from Wednesday, February 21, 2007)

SB 1176	RELATING TO CHILDREN. Amends early intervention services law to be consistent with the reauthorized Individuals with Disabilities Education Act of 2004.	HTH/HSP
SB 1110	RELATING TO HEALTH. Requires a hospital, including a public health facility, to provide information and emergency contraception to a sexual assault victim; requires training; includes penalties.	HTH
SB 1117	RELATING TO HEALTH. Requires recipients of state funding that provide sexual health education to provide medically accurate, factual information that is age-appropriate and includes education on both abstinence and contraception.	HTH
SB 1750	RELATING TO HEALTH. Requires a hospital, including a public health facility, to provide information regarding shaken baby syndrome to the parents of all newborns under its care.	HTH
SB 653	RELATING TO HEALTH CARE. Requires health care facilities and providers to notify the state designated protection and advocacy entity or agency prior to transferring a patient to an out-of-state health care facility.	HTH
