SB 707 SD1	RELATING TO A NEW MARKETS TAX CREDIT. Provides a new markets tax credit of one hundred per cent of the amount paid to a qualified community development entity located in Hawaii for a qualified equity investment; requires taxpayer to have received an allowance of credit under section 45D of the Internal Revenue Code, the federal new markets tax credit. (SD1)	EDT, WAM
SB 798 SD2	RELATING TO DISASTER RELIEF. Creates a one-time tax credit for victims of the October 15, 2006 earthquakes. (SD2)	IGM, EDT, WAM
SB 1365 SD1	RELATING TO THE INNOVATION ECONOMY. Requires the employees' retirement system to have \$100,000,000 allocated for Hawaii venture capital investments, unless it is not prudent to do so; appropriates funds to the University of Hawaii office of technology transfer and economic development to enter into a partnership with a private sector entity. (SD1)	EDT, WAM
SB 1925 SD1	RELATING TO SUSTAINABILITY. Establishes sustainable communities in Hawaii with the combined effort of state departments and agencies. (SD1)	WAH, WAM
