HB 1171 HD1 (HSCR963)	RELATING TO GOVERNMENT. Allows for contracts with private entities or persons for services lasting for no more than one year at a limited cost. (HB1171 HD1)	TSG/JDL, WAM (pending re-referral)
HB 19 HD2, SD1 (SSCR1233) Proposed SD2	RELATING TO EDUCATION. Establishes a new part for determining school impact fees for financing new or expanding existing department of education schools or facilities by requiring each school impact district to determine the appropriate student generation rates for the area. (SD2)	EDU, WAM

a. In person:

c. By E-mail: Testimony may also be e-mailed if less than 5 pages in length, to: testimony@capitol.hawaii.gov (the Public Access Room, phone 587-0478). Please indicate that 25 copies are needed. Please note that the Senator's office will not accept e-mail testimony.

Testimony received less than 24 hours prior to the hearing will be stamped "LATE."
