A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE SUPERVISION OF ADULT OFFENDERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 353B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§353B- Interstate transfer fee. The judiciary may
5 assess a fee not to exceed \$200 for each application made by a
6 parolee or probationer for a transfer out of the State; provided
7 that the fees collected shall be deposited into the State's
8 general fund."

9 SECTION 2. Section 353B-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

11 "(a) There is established the state council for interstate
12 adult offender supervision, which shall be placed
13 administratively in the judiciary. The council shall be
14 composed of [~~five~~] nine members to be appointed as follows:

15 (1) One member of the house of representatives appointed
16 by the speaker of the house of representatives;



- 1 (2) One member of the senate appointed by the senate
2 president;
- 3 (3) One member of the judiciary appointed by the chief
4 justice of the supreme court;
- 5 (4) The director of public safety, or the director's
6 designee;
- 7 (5) One member from the general public representing
8 victims groups appointed by the governor; [~~and~~]
- 9 (6) The prosecuting attorney of the city and county of
10 Honolulu, or the prosecuting attorney's designee;
- 11 (7) The attorney general, or the attorney general's
12 designee;
- 13 (8) The state public defender, or the state public
14 defender's designee; and
- 15 [~~+6~~] (9) The compact administrator, appointed by the
16 governor, with the advice and consent of the senate
17 and the chief justice.
- 18 With the exception of the director of public safety[~~7~~] or the
19 director's designee, and the compact administrator, the terms of
20 all members shall be for four years; provided that the victims
21 group representative and the compact administrator shall be
22 subject to confirmation proceedings under section 26-34. No



1 person, except the compact administrator, shall be appointed
2 consecutively to more than two terms.

3 There shall be one full-time coordinator position for the
4 supervision of adult offenders. The coordinator shall be
5 appointed by the judiciary."

6 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
