
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC WORKS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 104-28, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) ~~[Action]~~ The following civil actions may be
4 instituted in any court of competent jurisdiction:

5 (1) An action to recover unpaid wages or overtime
6 compensation may be maintained [~~in any court of~~
7 ~~competent jurisdiction~~] by any one or more laborers or
8 mechanics for and on behalf of oneself or themselves
9 and others similarly situated~~[-]~~; and

10 (2) An action for injunctive and other relief against an
11 employer that fails to pay the prevailing wage to its
12 employees as required by this chapter by a joint
13 labor-management committee established pursuant to
14 section 175a of the federal Labor Management
15 Cooperation Act of 1978 (29 U.S.C. 175a)."



1 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Description:

Allows a joint labor-management committee established pursuant to the federal Labor Management Cooperation Act of 1978 to institute an action for injunctive and other relief against an employer that fails to pay its employees the prevailing wage. Effective upon approval.
