
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. The purpose of this bill is to amend Hawaii's sentencing and related statutes to address the ruling of the United States Supreme Court in *Cunningham v. California*, decided on January 22, 2007.

SECTION 2. The Hawaii Penal Code is amended to effectuate the purpose of this Act.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
