## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HIGHER EDUCATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general  
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$413,000 or so much  
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008 as  
4 follows:

5           (1) \$120,000 for the establishment of two full-time  
6           equivalent (2.00 FTE) permanent instructional faculty  
7           at leeward community college;

8           (2) \$225,000 for the establishment of three full-time  
9           equivalent (3.00 FTE) permanent instructional faculty  
10          at the University of Hawaii at Manoa college of  
11          education;

12          (3) \$60,000 for the establishment of one full-time  
13          equivalent (1.00 FTE) administrative, professional,  
14          and technical personnel for leeward community college  
15          and University of Hawaii at Manoa college of education  
16          advising; and

17          (4) \$8,000 for educational equipment,


1 for additional resources to recruit, train, and retain  
2 prospective education assistants, paraprofessionals, and  
3 elementary and secondary teachers.

4 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of  
5 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

6 SECTION 1. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
