
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROTECTION OF CAVES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 6D-10, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:


3 "(a) Where the department determines in consultation with
4 the owner that dissemination of knowledge of cave location or
5 resources could be detrimental to their protection, then the
6 government information on the cave location and sensitive
7 resources shall be kept confidential[-], except that the
8 department may disclose such records to the office of Hawaiian
9 affairs, the appropriate island burial council, and recognized
10 descendants of burials located within the land parcel on which
11 the cave is located."


12 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
