
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PETROLEUM INDUSTRY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 78, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006, is amended
2 by amending sections 14 and 15 to read as follows:

3 "SECTION 14. There is appropriated out of the general
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of [~~\$17~~] \$500,000, or so
5 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year [~~2006-2007~~,]
6 2007-2008, to be deposited into the petroleum industry
7 monitoring, analysis, and reporting special fund.

8 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the public
9 utilities commission for the purposes of this part.

10 SECTION 15. There is appropriated out of the petroleum
11 industry monitoring, analysis, and reporting special fund the
12 sum of [~~\$17~~] \$500,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary
13 for fiscal year [~~2006-2007~~,] 2007-2008, to [~~establish the~~
14 ~~petroleum industry monitoring, analysis, and reporting program~~
15 ~~established under chapter 486J, Hawaii Revised Statutes.~~]:

16 (1) Establish and administer the petroleum monitoring,
17 analysis, and reporting program established under
18 chapter 486J, Hawaii Revised Statutes; and



1 (2) Establish two full-time staff positions in the public
 2 utilities commission to implement and maintain the
 3 petroleum monitoring, analysis, and reporting program,
 4 including the automated petroleum industry information
 5 reporting system established in section 486J-5.5,
 6 Hawaii Revised Statutes.

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the public
 8 utilities commission for the purposes of this part."

9 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

11 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
