
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE SECOND REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue
2 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$64,551,000, or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary, and the same sum, or so much
4 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated for fiscal years
5 2007-2008 and 2008-2009, for the purpose of financing capital
6 improvement projects for the second representative district, as
7 follows:

8 1. To be expended by the department of education:

9 Waiakea high school, Hawaii

10 Additional funds for construction and

11 track/field equipment and maintenance

12 equipment to complete the school's track

13 complex.

15 Equipment 456,000

16 Total funding \$ 2,956,000



1 2. To be expended by the department of land and natural
2 resources:

3 A. Wailoa small boat harbor, Hawaii
4 Design and construction improvements
5 that include maintenance dredging,
6 safety improvements, and other related
7 work.

11 B. Waiakea Kai, Hawaii

1 SECTION 2. The following sum, or so much thereof as shall
 2 be sufficient to finance the project listed below, is hereby
 3 appropriated out of private contributions for fiscal year 2007-
 4 2008:

5 Campus center, Hawaii
 6 Design and construction for additions and
 7 renovations to campus center.

8	Design	\$ 400,000
9	Construction	2,500,000
10	Total funding	\$ 2,900,000

11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of
 12 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

13 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of other federal
 14 funds of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$36,300,000, or so much
 15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal years 2007-2008 and 2008-
 16 2009, for the following capital improvement project:

17 U.S. Geological Survey Building, Hawaii
 18 Plans, design, construction, and equipment
 19 for the U.S. Geological Survey Building.
 20 This project is deemed necessary to qualify
 21 for federal aid financing and/or
 22 reimbursement:

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

8 of Hawaii at Hilo for the purpose of this Act.

9 SECTION 4. The appropriations made for the capital
10 improvement projects authorized by sections 1, 2, and 3 of this
11 Act shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal biennium for which
12 the appropriations are made; provided that all moneys from the
13 appropriations unencumbered as of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as
14 of that date.

15 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
