
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRAFFIC.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 264, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§264- Highway traffic advisory radio system; rules.

5 To protect the health and safety of the general public and to
6 help alleviate general traffic congestion, the department shall
7 establish and operate a county-wide highway traffic advisory
8 radio system to advise motorists of updated current traffic
9 conditions in any county having a population of greater than
10 three hundred thousand individuals. The department shall adopt
11 rules to implement the purpose of this section, including
12 determining the appropriate traffic advisory radio system."

13 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
14 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
15 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 to
16 establish and operate a county-wide highway traffic advisory
17 radio system to advise motorists of updated current traffic


3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
