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# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH INSURANCE.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 431, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to article 10A to be  
3 appropriately designated and to read as follows:

4           "§431:10A-       Oral chemotherapy treatment coverage.   Each  
5 accident and health or sickness policy, contract, plan, or  
6 agreement shall provide coverage for a prescribed chemotherapy  
7 agent as a medical benefit, and not as a drug benefit,  
8 regardless of whether the agent is to be administered  
9 intravenously, orally, or by injection."

10          SECTION 2. Chapter 432, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
11 amended by adding a new section to article 1 to be appropriately  
12 designated and to read as follows:

13          "§432:1-       Oral chemotherapy treatment coverage.   All  
14 individual or group hospital or medical service plan contracts  
15 shall provide coverage for a prescribed chemotherapy agent as a  
16 medical benefit, and not as a drug benefit, regardless of  
17 whether the agent is to be administered intravenously, orally,  
18 or by injection."



1 SECTION 3. Section 432D-23, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3 **"§432D-23 Required provisions and benefits.**

4 Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, each  
5 policy, contract, plan, or agreement issued in the [~~State~~] state  
6 after January 1, 1995, by health maintenance organizations  
7 pursuant to this chapter, shall include benefits provided in  
8 sections 431:10-212, 431:10A-115, 431:10A-115.5, 431:10A-116,  
9 431:10A-116.5, 431:10A-116.6, 431:10A-119, 431:10A-120, [~~and~~]  
10 431:10A-121, and 431:10A-\_\_\_\_\_, and chapter 431M."

11 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that  
12 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were  
13 begun, before its effective date.

14 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

16 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
