

1 (d) No later than one year after the effective date of
2 this Act, the board of education shall establish an internet
3 safety policy pursuant to this section."

4 SECTION 2. Chapter 312, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
5 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
6 and to read as follows:

7 "§312- Internet safety; library computers. (a) The
8 board of education shall establish an internet safety policy for
9 minors that includes monitoring the online activities of minors
10 and implementing a technology protection measure with respect to
11 any computers in public libraries that have internet access.

12 (b) The internet safety policy shall protect minors using
13 public library computers against access to visual depictions
14 that are:

15 (1) Obscene; or

16 (2) Harmful to minors.

17 (c) The board shall provide reasonable public notice and
18 shall hold at least one public hearing or meeting to address the
19 proposed internet safety policy pursuant to section 302A-1106.5.

20 (d) No later than one year after the effective date of
21 this Act, the board of education shall establish an internet
22 safety policy pursuant to this section."

Report Title:

Internet Safety Policy; Minors; Public Schools and Libraries

Description:

Requires the Board of Education to establish an Internet safety policy for minors with respect to the use of computers that have Internet access in public schools and libraries.
