
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INTOXICATING LIQUOR.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 712-1250.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (4) to read as follows:

3 "(4) Promoting intoxicating liquor to a person under the
4 age of twenty-one is a petty misdemeanor. Any person convicted
5 of violating this section may be sentenced as follows:

6 (a) For a first conviction, the person may serve a minimum
7 term of imprisonment of no fewer than ten days;

8 (b) For a second conviction within five years, the person
9 may serve a term of imprisonment of no fewer than
10 twenty days; and

11 (c) For a third or subsequent conviction within five
12 years, the person may serve a term of imprisonment of
13 no fewer than thirty days."

14 SECTION 2. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
