9	<u>(b)</u>	For a second conviction within five years, the person
10		may serve a term of imprisonment of no fewer than
11		twenty days; and
12	<u>(c)</u>	For a third or subsequent conviction within five
13		years, the person may serve a term of imprisonment of
14		no fewer than thirty days."

## Report Title:

Promoting Liquor to Minors; Sentencing

## Description:

Changes the classification of the offense of promoting intoxicating liquor to a minor from a misdemeanor to a petty misdemeanor. Requires a minimum 24-hour jail sentence for the first offense. (HB2036 HD1)
