# A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the college of  
2 engineering at the University of Hawaii at Manoa is an integral  
3 part of workforce development for the innovation economy.

4           The legislature further finds that to enhance technology  
5 growth and development as well as workforce development in  
6 Hawaii, the college of engineering at the University of Hawaii  
7 at Manoa needs additional faculty for research as well as for  
8 professional development and distance learning.

9           The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the  
10 college of engineering at the University of Hawaii at Manoa for  
11 two full-time equivalent positions for an associate dean for  
12 research and a director of professional development and distance  
13 learning.

14           SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1 or so much thereof  
16 as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for two full-time  
17 equivalent positions for an associate dean for research and a



1 director of professional development and distance learning at  
2 the college of engineering at the University of Hawaii at Manoa.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of  
4 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
