A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the college of
- 2 engineering at the University of Hawaii at Manoa is an integral
- 3 part of workforce development for the innovation economy.
- 4 The legislature further finds that to enhance technology
- 5 growth and development as well as workforce development in
- 6 Hawaii, the college of engineering at the University of Hawaii
- 7 at Manoa needs additional faculty for research as well as for
- 8 professional development and distance learning.
- 9 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to the
- 10 college of engineering at the University of Hawaii at Manoa for
- 11 two full-time equivalent positions for an associate dean for
- 12 research and a director of professional development and distance
- 13 learning.
- 14 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 15 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1 or so much thereof
- 16 as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for two full-time
- 17 equivalent positions for an associate dean for research and a

- 1 director of professional development and distance learning at
- 2 the college of engineering at the University of Hawaii at Manoa.
- 3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of
- 4 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
