## A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR COMMUNITY-BASED ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the business 2 community, community-based non-profit organizations, and other 3 entrepreneurs require a functional, service-oriented agency that is readily available to provide business counseling, financial 4 5 backing, and general support to foster real community-based 6 economic development for the various products and services 7 demonstrating and embracing Hawaii's diversified economy. Further, the legislature finds that besides a growing financial 8 9 need in Hawaii's non-profit communities, Hawaii's residents 10 demand a clear and open process for grant-giving and 11 accountability by the organizations receiving financial 12 assistance. 13 The Hawaii community-based economic development technical

and financial assistance program within the department of

business, economic development, and tourism was established for

this purpose. The legislature established the Hawaii community
based economic development technical and financial assistance

- 1 program in Act 111, Session Laws of Hawaii 1990, codified as
- 2 chapter 210D, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to provide financial
- 3 assistance to community-based organizations and community-based
- 4 enterprises through low-interest loans and grants to qualifying
- 5 applicants.
- 6 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds for the
- 7 Hawaii community-based economic development technical and
- 8 financial assistance program to assist qualifying community-
- 9 based organizations statewide.
- 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$500,000 or so much
- 12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 to be paid
- 13 into the Hawaii community-based economic development revolving
- 14 fund created in section 210D-4, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
- 15 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the Hawaii
- 16 community-based economic development revolving fund the sum of
- 17 \$500,000 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 18 2008-2009 for low-interest loans and grants to qualifying
- 19 community-based organizations involved in economic development
- 20 activities under Hawaii community-based economic development
- 21 technical and financial assistance program.

- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 2 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of
- 3 this Act.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2034.
