
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOPEDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 291C-197, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

3 "(a) Wherever bicycle lanes are provided on [~~the~~] a
4 roadway[~~7~~] with a speed limit of greater than thirty-five miles
5 per hour, moped drivers shall use such bicycle lanes. Moped
6 drivers may use bicycle lanes on a roadway with a speed limit of
7 thirty-five miles per hour or less."

8 SECTION 2. Section 291C-198, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
9 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

10 "(b) No person shall drive a moped at a speed greater than
11 either thirty-five miles per hour (fifty-eight kilometers per
12 hour) [~~7~~] or the posted speed limit for the roadway if less than
13 thirty-five miles per hour. This prohibition shall apply
14 whether a person drives a moped on a roadway laned for motor
15 vehicles or on a bicycle lane."

16 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.



1 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
