## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HISTORIC PRESERVATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Act 59, Session Laws of Hawaii 2003 (Act 59),  
2 established the South Kona wilderness area on the island of  
3 Hawaii. The Act authorized the department of land and natural  
4 resources to acquire private lands in the area and directed the  
5 department to preserve the visual, cultural, and historical  
6 aspects of, and to develop a comprehensive management plan for,  
7 the South Kona wilderness area.

8           Act 59 was subsequently amended by Act 215, Session Laws of  
9 Hawaii 2006, to extend the deadline for acquiring these lands to  
10 December 30, 2007.

11           However, the Legislature finds that more time is necessary  
12 to complete the acquisition. Therefore, the purpose of this Act  
13 is to further extend the deadline for acquiring any private  
14 lands within the South Kona wilderness area on the island of  
15 Hawaii to December 30, 2009.

16           SECTION 2. Act 59, Session Laws of Hawaii 2003, as amended  
17 by Act 215, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006, is amended by amending  
18 section 4 to read as follows:

South Kona Wilderness Area; Historic Preservation

**Description:**

Extends the time allowed to acquire the lands designated as part of the South Kona Wilderness Area on the island of Hawaii.
