10		to <u>inject</u> , ingest [methamphetamine.], inhale, or
11		otherwise introduce into the minor's body any
12		controlled substance that has not been prescribed by a
13		physician for the minor, except as permitted under
14		section 329-122."
15	SECT	ION 2. Section 709-904, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
16	amended b	y amending subsection (1) to read as follows:

6	(b)	Recklessly causes or permits the minor to inject,	
7		ingest [methamphetamine.], inhale, or otherwise

9		substance that has not been prescribed by a physician
