# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SENIOR CENTERS.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The legislature recognizes that senior centers  
2 in our islands, among other things, provide invaluable services  
3 to seniors that encompass a host of social, educational, and  
4 cultural opportunities, as well as activities that support  
5 healthy lifestyles.

6           The purpose of this Act is to appropriate funds to support  
7 the operations of certain senior centers on Oahu so that they  
8 may continue to enhance the quality of senior life in their  
9 respective communities.

10          SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general  
11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$                    or so  
12 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 to  
13 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii  
14 Revised Statutes, for operating expenses to be distributed as  
15 follows:

16          (1) \$           to Catholic Charities Hawaii for the Lanakila  
17               Multi-Purpose Senior Center;



1           (2)   \$           for the Kapahulu Center;

2           (3)   \$           for the Moiliili Community Center; and

3           (4)   \$           for the Waikiki Community Center.

4           The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of  
5 health for the purposes of this Act.

6           SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
