
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CRUELTY TO ANIMALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 711, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§711- Cruelty to animals; dog fighting; penalty.

5 (1) (a) No person shall cause, sponsor, arrange, hold, or
6 encourage a fight between dogs for the purpose of
7 monetary gain or entertainment.

8 (b) For the purpose of this section, a person encourages a
9 fight between dogs for the purpose of monetary gain or
10 entertainment if the person:

11 (i) Is knowingly present at or wagers on a dog fight;

12 (ii) Owns, trains, transports, possesses, breeds,
13 sells, transfers, or equips a dog with the intent
14 that the dog will be engaged in a fight;

15 (iii) Knowingly allows a dog fight to occur on any
16 property owned or controlled by the person;

17 (iv) Knowingly allows any dog used for a fight to be
18 kept, boarded, housed, or trained on, or



1 transported in, any property owned or controlled
2 by the person;

3 (v) Knowingly uses any means of communication for the
4 purpose of promoting a dog fight; or

5 (vi) Knowingly possesses any dog used for a fight or
6 any device intended to enhance the animal's
7 fighting ability.

8 (2) Nothing in this section shall prohibit any of the
9 following:

10 (a) The use of dogs in the management of livestock by the
11 owner of the livestock or the owner's employees or
12 agents or other persons in lawful custody thereof;

13 (b) The use of dogs in hunting wildlife including game; or

14 (c) The training of dogs or the use of equipment in the
15 training of dogs for any purpose not prohibited by
16 law.

17 (3) Dog fighting is a class C felony. Any person
18 committing a second or subsequent offense under this section
19 shall be sentenced to:

20 (a) An indeterminate term of imprisonment of five years,
21 pursuant to section 706-660; or



1 (b) Five years probation, with conditions to include a
2 term of imprisonment of not less than thirty days
3 without possibility of suspension of sentence.

4 (4) If there is any conflict between this section and
5 section 711-1109, or any other provision of law, this section
6 shall apply."

7 SECTION 2. Section 711-1109.3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
8 repealed.

9 [~~§711-1109.3 Cruelty to animals; fighting dogs. (1) A~~
10 ~~person commits the offense of cruelty to animals if the person:~~

11 ~~(a) Owns or trains any dog with the intent that such dog~~
12 ~~shall be engaged in an exhibition of fighting with~~

14 ~~(b) For amusement or gain, intentionally causes any dog to~~
15 ~~fight with another dog, or causes any dog to injure~~

19 ~~under the person's charge or control, or aids or abets~~

21 ~~(2) Nothing in this section shall prohibit any of the~~


12 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that

14 began, before its effective date.






15 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
