
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CRUELTY TO ANIMALS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 711, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
3 and to read as follows:

4 "§711- Dog fighting. (1) A person commits the offense
5 of dog fighting if the person causes, sponsors, arranges, holds,
6 or encourages a fight between dogs for the purpose of monetary
7 gain or entertainment, including:

8 (a) Knowingly wagering on a dog fight;

9 (b) Owning, training, transporting, possessing, breeding,
10 selling, transferring, or equipping a dog with the
11 intent that the dog will be engaged in a fight;

12 (c) Knowingly allowing a dog fight to occur on any
13 property owned or controlled by the person;

14 (d) Knowingly allowing any dog intended by the person to
15 be used for a fight to be kept, boarded, housed,
16 trained on, or transported in, any property owned or
17 controlled by the person;



- 1 (e) Knowingly using any means of communication for the
2 promotion of dog fighting; or
- 3 (f) Knowingly possessing any dog intended by the person to
4 be used for a fight or any device intended to enhance
5 the animal's fighting ability. As used in this
6 paragraph, "device" means both animate and inanimate
7 objects and includes live animals used as bait
8 animals.

9 (2) Nothing in this section shall prohibit any of the
10 following:

- 11 (a) The use of dogs in the management of livestock by the
12 owner of the livestock, the owner's employees or
13 agents, or other persons in lawful custody thereof;
- 14 (b) The use of dogs in hunting wildlife, including game;
15 or
- 16 (c) The training of dogs or the use of equipment in the
17 training of dogs for any purpose not prohibited by
18 law.

19 (3) Dog fighting is a class C felony. Any person
20 committing a second or subsequent offense under this section
21 shall be sentenced to:



1 (a) An indeterminate term of imprisonment of five years,
2 pursuant to section 706-660; or

3 (b) Five years probation, with conditions to include a
4 term of imprisonment of no fewer than thirty days
5 without possibility of suspension of sentence.

6 (4) If there is any conflict between this section and
7 sections 711-1108.5, 711-1109, or any other provision of law,
8 this section shall apply."

9 SECTION 2. Section 711-1109.3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10 repealed.

12 ~~person commits the offense of cruelty to animals if the person:~~

13 ~~(a) Owns or trains any dog with the intent that such dog~~

16 ~~(b) For amusement or gain, intentionally causes any dog to~~

6 ~~(b) The use of dogs in hunting wildlife including game; or~~

10 ~~(3) Violation of this section shall be a class C felony.~~

11 ~~(4) If there is any conflict between this section and~~
12 ~~section 711-1109, or any other provision of law, this section~~
13 ~~shall apply."]~~

14 SECTION 3. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
15 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
16 begun, before its effective date.

17 SECTION 4. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
18 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

19 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2112.
