
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 304A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and
3 to read as follows:

4 **"PART . CRAFTS SCHOOL**

5 **§304A- Purpose.** The purpose of the crafts school is to
6 certify crafts persons and subcontractors in the crafts trade.

7 **§304A- School; establishment.** There is established
8 within the community college system a crafts school to meet the
9 critical shortfalls in the supply of competent persons to
10 provide crafts work in public and private works and projects.

11 **§304A- Administration.** The community college system may
12 plan and administer the crafts school with the advice of the
13 workforce development council, the department of education, and
14 the construction industry.

15 **§304A- Annual report.** The office of the vice president
16 for community colleges shall prepare an annual report to the
17 legislature on the status of the program. This annual report
18 shall include data on the development of a crafts curriculum and



1 content, teaching standards throughout the system, and overall
2 achievement. The annual report shall be submitted no later than
3 twenty days prior to the convening of each regular legislative
4 session."

5 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
6 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
7 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for the
8 establishment of a crafts school in the community colleges of
9 the University of Hawaii system.

10 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the University of
11 Hawaii for the purposes of this Act.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
