
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO FIREARMS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 134-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (c) to read as follows:

3 "(c) The manufacture, possession, sale, barter, trade,
4 gift, transfer, or acquisition of detachable ammunition
5 magazines [~~with a capacity in excess of ten rounds which~~] that
6 are designed for or capable of use with a pistol, but are not
7 authorized for use with the pistol by its manufacturer, is
8 prohibited. [~~This subsection shall not apply to magazines~~
9 ~~originally designed to accept more than ten rounds of ammunition~~
10 ~~which have been modified to accept no more than ten rounds and~~
11 ~~which are not capable of being readily restored to a capacity of~~
12 ~~more than ten rounds.~~"]"

13 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Report Title:

Firearms; Ammunition Magazine Capacity

Description:

Permits owner of a pistol to use any ammunition magazine authorized for use with the pistol by the manufacturer of the pistol. Repeals the prohibition on magazines with a capacity in excess of ten rounds.
