
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN TRAFFICKING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 260, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006, is
2 amended as follows:

3 1. By amending subsection (a) of section 2 to read:

4 "(a) There is established the Hawaii anti-trafficking task
5 force. The anti-trafficking task force shall be comprised of
6 the following:

7 (1) Individuals:

8 [~~(1)~~] (A) The attorney general, or the attorney general's
9 ~~[designees,]~~ designee;

10 [~~(2)~~] (B) The directors of health, human services, and
11 labor~~[,]~~ and industrial relations, or their
12 designees;

15 [~~(3)~~] (D) The chief of police of each county, or the
16 chief's designee;

17 [~~(4)~~] (E) The prosecuting attorney of each county, or the
18 prosecutor's designee;

3 attorney, city and county of Honolulu;
- 4 (G) Hawaii contractees for services under the office
5 of refugee resettlement of the United States
6 Department of Health and Human Services; and
- 7 (H) Hawaii contractees for services under the United
8 States Conference of Catholic Bishops;
- 9 and
- 10 (2) Representatives of:
- 11 (A) The immigration information office of the county
12 of Hawaii;
- 13 (B) The crime victim compensation commission;
- 14 (C) The office of the gender equity counselor of the
15 University of Hawaii;
- 16 (D) The Hawaii State Coalition Against Domestic
17 Violence;
- 18 [~~6~~] (E) The Salvation Army;
- 19 [~~7~~] ~~Sisters Offering Support;~~
- 20 [~~8~~] (F) The Sex Abuse Treatment Center;
- 21 [~~9~~] (G) GirlFest;

3 [~~(11)~~] (I) The Domestic Violence [~~Clearinghouse and Legal~~

6 Assault.

7 [~~The Task Force~~] Task force members shall serve without
8 compensation but [~~shall~~] may be reimbursed for expenses,
9 including travel expenses, necessary for the performance of
10 their duties~~[-]~~, subject to the availability of funds."

11 2. By amending subsections (d) and (e) of section 2 to
12 read:

13 "(d) Not less than twenty days prior to the convening of
14 the regular sessions of 2007 [~~and~~], 2008, and 2009, the task
15 force shall provide to the legislature a report on its
16 activities~~[-]~~; provided that not less than twenty days prior to
17 the convening of the regular session of 2010, the task force
18 shall provide the legislature a final report of its activities,
19 including findings and recommendations, and any proposed
20 legislation.

21 (e) The task force shall cease to exist on June 30,
22 [~~2008.~~] 2010."
