
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HUMAN TRAFFICKING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 260, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006, is
2 amended as follows:

3 1. By amending subsection (a) of section 2 to read:

4 "(a) There is established the Hawaii anti-trafficking task
5 force. The anti-trafficking task force shall be comprised of
6 the following:

7 (1) Individuals:

8 ~~[(1)]~~ (A) The attorney general, or the attorney general's
9 designees;

10 ~~[(2)]~~ (B) The directors of health, human services, and
11 labor, or their designees;

12 (C) The state public defender, or the state public
13 defender's designee;

14 ~~[(3)]~~ (D) The chief of police of each county, or the
15 chief's designee;

16 ~~[(4)]~~ (E) The prosecuting attorney of each county, or the
17 prosecutor's designee;

3 attorney, city and county of Honolulu;
- 4 (G) Hawaii contractees for services under the office
5 of refugee resettlement of the United States
6 Department of Health and Human Services; and
- 7 (H) Hawaii contractees for services under the United
8 States Conference of Catholic Bishops; and
- 9 (2) Representatives of:
- 10 (A) The immigration information office of the county
11 of Hawaii;
- 12 (B) The crime victim compensation commission;
- 13 (C) The office of the gender equity counselor of the
14 University of Hawaii;
- 15 (D) The Hawaii State Coalition Against Domestic
16 Violence;
- 17 ~~[-6]~~ (E) The Salvation Army;
- 18 ~~[-7]~~ ~~Sisters Offering Support;~~
- 19 ~~[-8]~~ (F) The Sex Abuse Treatment Center;
- 20 ~~[-9]~~ (G) GirlFest;
- 21 ~~[-10]~~ (H) Na Loio Immigrant Rights and Public Interest

5 ~~[The Task Force]~~ Task force members shall serve without
 6 compensation but shall be reimbursed for expenses, including
 7 travel expenses, necessary for the performance of their duties."

8 2. By amending subsections (d) and (e) of section 2 to
 9 read:

10 "(d) Not less than twenty days prior to the convening of
 11 the regular sessions of 2007 ~~[and]~~, 2008, and 2009, the task
 12 force shall provide to the legislature a report on its
 13 activities~~[-]~~; provided that not less than twenty days prior to
 14 the convening of the regular session of 2010, the task force
 15 shall provide the legislature a final report of its activities,
 16 including findings and recommendations, and any proposed
 17 legislation.

18 (e) The task force shall cease to exist on June 30,
 19 ~~[2008-]~~ 2010."

20 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
 21 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
 22 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for



1 travel and clerical expenses of the Hawaii anti-trafficking task
2 force.

3 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
4 the attorney general for the purposes of this Act.

5 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008;
8 provided that section 1 shall take effect on June 29, 2008.
