## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE  
FIFTH REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. The following sums or so much thereof as shall  
2 be sufficient to finance the projects listed in this Act are  
3 hereby appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of  
4 Hawaii for fiscal year 2008-2009:

5           1. To be expended by the Hawaii county department of  
6 public works:

7           A. Mamalahoa highway, Hawaii

8           Plans, design, and construction to extend the  
9 northbound left turn collector lane on Mamalahoa  
10 highway at Konawaena elementary school.

9 A. Ka`u high school, Hawaii

10 Design, construction, and equipment for a new  
 11 gymnasium which shall also serve as a disaster  
 12 shelter.

14	Construction	\$10,000,000
15	Equipment	\$100,000
16	Total funding	\$10,900,000

17 4. To be expended by the department of land and natural  
 18 resources:

19 A. Kaawaloa access road, Hawaii

20 Plans, design, and construction for a new access road  
 21 to Kaawaloa (off Hokuulia bypass road) in South Kona.

5 SECTION 2. The sums appropriated for the respective  
6 capital projects set forth in section 1 shall be expended by the  
7 designated expending agency for the purposes of this Act.
