## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PARKING FOR PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Chapter 291, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated  
3 and to read as follows:

4           "§291-       Nursing facility; eligibility. (a) A nursing  
5 facility may be issued a special license plate under section  
6 291-51.5, for a vehicle registered in the nursing facility's  
7 name that is used to transport persons with a disability.

8           (b) A nursing facility may be issued a temporary removable  
9 windshield placard under section 291-51.6, or a removable  
10 windshield placard under section 291-52, for a vehicle  
11 registered in the nursing facility's name that is used to  
12 transport persons with a disability."

13           SECTION 2. Section 291-51, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
14 amended as follows:

15           1. By adding a new definition to be appropriately inserted  
16 and to read:



1        "Nursing facility" means a nursing facility licensed under  
2 section 321-15.6 or 321-15.62, or any other facility that  
3 provides residential care for persons with a disability."

4        2. By amending the definitions of "removable windshield  
5 placard" and "temporary removable windshield placard" to read:

6        "'Removable windshield placard" means a two-sided, hanger-  
7 style placard issued under this part to a person with a  
8 disability who presents a certificate of disability that  
9 verifies that the applicant's disability is expected to last for  
10 at least four years[-], or to a nursing facility for use in  
11 transporting persons with a disability.

12        "Temporary removable windshield placard" means a two-sided,  
13 hanger-style placard issued under this part to a person with a  
14 disability who presents a certificate of disability that  
15 verifies the person's disability in monthly increments, which  
16 shall not exceed six months[-], or to a nursing facility for use  
17 in transporting persons with a disability."

18        SECTION 3. Section 291-52.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
19 amended to read as follows:

20        "**§291-52.5 Issuance of identification card.** Each issuing  
21 agency shall issue one identification card at the same time it  
22 issues a removable windshield placard, temporary removable



1 windshield placard, or special license plates to a person with a  
2 disability[-], or to a nursing facility for use in transporting  
3 persons with a disability."

4 SECTION 4. Section 291-57, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
5 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:

6 "(a) Any person who uses a parking space reserved for  
7 persons with disabilities who:

- 8 (1) Fails to properly display a removable windshield  
9 placard, a temporary removable windshield placard, or  
10 special license plates;
- 11 (2) Displays an invalid removable windshield placard, an  
12 invalid temporary removable windshield placard, or  
13 invalid special license plates;
- 14 (3) Uses a removable windshield placard, a temporary  
15 removable windshield placard, or special license plate  
16 that was not issued to that person, the nursing  
17 facility that is the registered owner of the vehicle,  
18 or to any passengers occupying the vehicle in the  
19 parking space; or
- 20 (4) With or without a removable windshield placard, a  
21 temporary removable windshield placard, or special  
22 license plates:



1 (A) Parks in an access aisle; or  
 2 (B) Obstructs the ingress or egress to a parking  
 3 space reserved for a person with a disability[+],  
 4 shall be guilty of a traffic infraction under chapter 291D and  
 5 shall be fined not less than \$250 nor more than \$500 and pay any  
 6 costs incurred by the court related to assessing the fine;  
 7 provided that a person with a disability who has been issued a  
 8 valid placard or special license plate that is currently in  
 9 effect, and who has failed to display the placard or license  
 10 plate while parking in a space reserved for persons with  
 11 disabilities, shall pay a fine of not less than \$25 nor more  
 12 than \$100 and any costs incurred by the court related to  
 13 assessing the fine."

14 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

16 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
