
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR THE STATEWIDE LANGUAGE ACCESS BANK.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that through the creation
2 of a statewide language access bank, the State will have a
3 centralized resource to:

- 4 (1) Maintain a roster of language interpreters and
5 translators;
6 (2) Match and refer language interpreters and translators
7 to meet the needs of government agencies, and non-
8 profit and for-profit organizations;
9 (3) Provide and coordinate training to develop language
10 interpretation and translation skills; and
11 (4) Work towards testing and certification of language
12 interpreters and translators to ensure the quality and
13 accuracy of their services.

14 After its initial establishment, the language access bank
15 will be self-sustaining, supported by user fees, subscription
16 and training fees, and the combined resources of government
17 agencies, and for-profit and non-profit entities.



1 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate moneys for
2 initial funding needed to establish the language access bank.


3 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$189,500 or so much
5 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 to create
6 a statewide language access bank in the office of language
7 access to assist state agencies and covered entities in
8 providing interpretation and translation services to limited
9 English proficient individuals in accordance with Hawaii's
10 language access laws.

11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
12 labor and industrial relations for the purposes of this Act.

13 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
