
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR FERAL PIG ABATEMENT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 for the
4 reduction and abatement of the feral pig population, including
5 the purchase and maintenance of tools and equipment necessary
6 for abatement activities, such as box traps, baits, and corrals.

7 The sum expended shall be expended by the department of
8 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
