









BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 104-32, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "**§104-32 Suspension during emergency.** During a national
4 emergency declared by the President or the Congress of the
5 United States, or a state of emergency declared by the governor,
6 subject to the provisions of section 127-10, the governor, by
7 executive order in writing, may suspend this chapter[-];
8 provided that the governor may not suspend this chapter except
9 in the event such an emergency occurs and is so proclaimed."

10 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
