
A BILL FOR AN ACT

MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE HAWAII HEALTH
SYSTEMS CORPORATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. This Act is recommended by the governor for
2 immediate passage in accordance with section 9 of article VII of
3 the Constitution of the State of Hawaii.

4 SECTION 2. This emergency appropriation is necessary to
5 ensure that the Hawaii health systems corporation can pay for
6 operation and provision of current levels of service at Leahi
7 Hospital, Maluhia, Samuel Mahelona Memorial Hospital, Lana'i
8 Community Hospital, Hilo Medical Center, Ka'u Hospital, Kona
9 Community Hospital, and Kohala Hospital.

10 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate \$14,000,000 in
11 general funds for fiscal year 2007-2008 to adjust accounts
12 payable remittances to no more than forty-five days from the
13 date of the invoice for Hawaii health systems corporation's
14 facilities in order to bring current accounts payable balances
15 that are due to essential vendors. This will allow delivery of
16 goods and services to these facilities to continue on a timely
17 basis so that the facilities will be able to maintain
18 operations.

1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$14,000,000, or so
3 much thereof as may be necessary, for fiscal year 2007-2008 to
4 be used by the Hawaii health systems corporation to pay accounts
5 payable within forty-five days from the date of the invoice for
6 Hawaii health systems corporation's facilities.

7 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii health
8 systems corporation for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

JUSTIFICATION SHEET

DEPARTMENT: Health

TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT MAKING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION TO THE HAWAII HEALTH SYSTEMS CORPORATION.

PURPOSE: To provide emergency funding to the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation to allow it to pay accounts payable within 45 days.

MEANS: Emergency appropriation of general funds for the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation for fiscal year 2007-2008.

JUSTIFICATION: The Hawaii Health Systems Corporation needs to be able to pay its vendors and service providers to ensure continuity of services. This request for an emergency appropriation is submitted to allow the Hawaii Health Systems Corporation to pay accounts payable within 45 days.

Impact on the public: This emergency appropriation will allow Hawaii Health Systems Corporation to continue to provide services necessary to meet community healthcare needs.
