## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO GROUNDED VESSELS.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 200-47.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(b) Solely for the purposes of removal and with no
- 4 liability to the department, the department may assume control
- 5 of any vessel that:
- 6 (1) Is grounded on a coral reef or in imminent danger of
- 7 breaking up; and
- **8** (2) Cannot be immediately removed by the owner within
- 9 seventy-two hours in a manner that is reasonably safe,
- 10 as determined by the department.
- 11 Once the department assumes control over the vessel, the vessel
- 12 shall be [directed to a safer location.] removed by conventional
- 13 salvage methods to minimize damage to the natural resources and
- 14 not become a hazard to navigation. All costs and expenses of
- 15 removing the vessel and [damages] damage to state or private
- 16 property shall be the sole responsibility of the vessel's owner
- 17 or operator. This section shall apply whether the vessel is
- 18 attended or deemed derelict under section 200-48."
