
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 245-15, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended to read as follows:

3 "**§245-15 Disposition of revenues.** All moneys collected
4 pursuant to this chapter shall be paid into the state treasury
5 as state realizations to be kept and accounted for as provided
6 by law; provided that, of the moneys collected under the tax
7 imposed pursuant to:

8 (1) Section 245-3(a)(5), after September 30, 2006, and
9 prior to October 1, 2007, 1.0 cent per cigarette shall
10 be deposited to the credit of the Hawaii cancer
11 research special fund, established pursuant to section
12 304A-2168, for research and operating expenses;

13 (2) Section 245-3(a)(6), after September 30, 2007, and
14 prior to October 1, 2008:

15 (A) 1.5 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
16 credit of the Hawaii cancer research special
17 fund, established pursuant to section 304A-2168,

1 for research and operating expenses [7] and for
2 capital expenditures;

3 (B) 0.25 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
4 credit of the trauma system special fund
5 established pursuant to section 321-22.5 and

6 (C) 0.25 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
7 credit of the emergency medical services special
8 fund established pursuant to section 321-234;

9 (3) Section 245-3(a)(7), after September 30, 2008, and
10 prior to October 1, 2009:

11 (A) 2.0 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
12 credit of the Hawaii cancer research special
13 fund, established pursuant to section 304A-2168,
14 for research and operating expenses [7] and for
15 capital expenditures;

16 (B) 0.5 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
17 credit of the trauma system special fund
18 established pursuant to section 321-22.5;

19 (C) 0.25 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
20 credit of the community health centers special
21 fund; and

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- 1 (D) 0.25 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
2 credit of the emergency medical services special
3 fund established pursuant to section 321-234;
- 4 (4) Section 245-3(a)(8), after September 30, 2009, and
5 prior to October 1, 2010:
- 6 (A) 2.0 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
7 credit of the Hawaii cancer research special
8 fund, established pursuant to section 304A-2168,
9 for research and operating expenses [7] and for
10 capital expenditures;
- 11 (B) 0.75 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
12 credit of the trauma system special fund
13 established pursuant to section 321-22.5;
- 14 (C) 0.75 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
15 credit of the community health centers special
16 fund; and
- 17 (D) 0.5 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
18 credit of the emergency medical services special
19 fund established pursuant to section 321-234;
- 20 (5) Section 245-3(a)(9), after September 30, 2010, and
21 prior to October 1, 2011:

- 1 (A) 2.0 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
2 credit of the Hawaii cancer research special
3 fund, established pursuant to section 304A-2168,
4 for research and operating expenses [7] and for
5 capital expenditures;
- 6 (B) 1.0 cent per cigarette shall be deposited to the
7 credit of the trauma system special fund
8 established pursuant to section 321-22.5;
- 9 (C) 1.0 cent per cigarette shall be deposited to the
10 credit of the community health centers special
11 fund; and
- 12 (D) 1.0 cent per cigarette shall be deposited to the
13 credit of the emergency medical services special
14 fund established pursuant to section 321-234; and
- 15 (6) Section 245-3(a)(10), after September 30, 2011, and
16 thereafter:
- 17 (A) 2.0 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
18 credit of the Hawaii cancer research special
19 fund, established pursuant to section 304A-2168,
20 for research and operating expenses [7] and for
21 capital expenditures;

1 (B) 1.5 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
2 credit of the trauma system special fund
3 established pursuant to section 321-22.5;

4 (C) 1.25 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
5 credit of the community health centers special
6 fund; and

7 (D) 1.25 cents per cigarette shall be deposited to the
8 credit of the emergency medical services special
9 fund established pursuant to section 321-234."

10 SECTION 2. Section 304A-2168, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
11 amended by amending subsections (b) and (c) to read as follows:

12 "(b) The moneys in the special fund shall be used by the
13 University of Hawaii for the cancer research center of Hawaii's
14 research and operating expenses[-] and capital expenditures.

15 (c) The following shall be deposited into the special
16 fund:

17 (1) Moneys collected pursuant to section 245-15; [~~and~~]

18 (2) Interest earned or accrued on moneys in the special
19 fund[-]; and

20 (3) All other fees, charges, and other moneys received in
21 conjunction with cancer center programs or through
22 transfers from other accounts or funds."

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1 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
2 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

3 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.

Description:

To increase the sources of revenue available to support the Cancer Research Center of Hawaii.

JUSTIFICATION SHEET

DEPARTMENT: University of Hawaii
TITLE: A BILL FOR AN ACT RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

PURPOSE: To increase the sources of revenue available to support the Cancer Research Center of Hawaii's (CRCH) emergency medical services, trauma care, and community health centers, and other related programs by allowing moneys in the Hawaii Cancer Research Special Fund to be used for capital expenditures, and allowing other fees, charges, and other moneys received in conjunction with cancer center programs or through transfers from other accounts or funds to be deposited into the Cancer Research Center Special Fund.

MEANS: Amend sections 245-15, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and 304A-2168(b) and (c), Hawaii Revised Statutes.

JUSTIFICATION: One source of revenue to fund CRCH's operations is the cigarette tax. Other sources of revenue are needed to ensure that the CRCH will be adequately funded. It is envisioned that other revenues can be derived from cancer center programs, and that these revenues would be used to further cancer research and care in Hawaii.

Impact on the public: Other revenues derived from CRCH will be used to supplement or replace state funds. The potential public benefit will be increased fiscal self-sufficiency for CRCH.

Impact on the department and other agencies: The proposed amendment will provide CRCH with increased flexibility to develop other sources of revenue to finance its program requirements. The increasing number of

cancer patients has amplified the need for expanded cancer research in Hawaii. The additional flexibility will provide an opportunity to advance the goals of the CRCH.
