
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO SENIOR CENTERS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature recognizes that senior centers
2 in our islands, among other things, provide invaluable services
3 to seniors that encompass a host of social, educational, and
4 cultural opportunities, as well as activities that support
5 healthy lifestyles. The purpose of this Act is to support the
6 operations of certain senior centers on Oahu so that they may
7 continue to enhance the quality of senior life in their
8 respective communities.

9 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
10 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
11 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2008-2009 to
12 provide funding for grants pursuant to chapter 42F, Hawaii
13 Revised Statutes, for the operations of the Lanakila Multi-
14 Purpose Senior Center, the Kapahulu Center, the Moiliili
15 Community Center, and the Waikiki Community Center.

16 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
17 human services for the purposes of this Act.
