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**A BILL FOR AN ACT**

AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS FOR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS FOR THE SECOND REPRESENTATIVE DISTRICT.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1    Part I.

2                          SECTION 1. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
3 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$                          or so much  
4 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
5 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2008-2009  
6 for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for  
7 the second representative district, as follows:

8 1. To be expended by the department of education:

9                          Keaukaha elementary school, Hawaii  
10                          For design, construction, and equipment  
11                          of a 6,000 square-foot cafeteria  
12                          kitchen/dining room.

1 SECTION 2. The sums appropriated for the respective  
2 capital projects set forth in section 1 of this part shall be  
3 expended by the designated expending agencies for the purposes  
4 of this part.

5 SECTION 3. The appropriations made for the capital  
6 improvement projects authorized by this part shall not lapse at  
7 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriations are  
8 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriations  
9 unencumbered as of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as of that date.

10 Part II.

11 SECTION 4. The legislature finds that it appropriated  
12 moneys in the amount of \$18,207,000 for the Hawaii community  
13 college Manono campus, Komohana campus, and west Hawaii campus  
14 in Act 160, Session Laws of Hawaii 2006. The appropriation  
15 included moneys for plans, design, construction, and equipment  
16 for the development of Hawaii community college at the Manono  
17 campus, the Komohana campus situated mauka of Komohana street,  
18 and west Hawaii campus center projects to include ground and  
19 site improvements, equipment, appurtenances, and all related  
20 project costs. To date, only \$2,000,000 of the appropriation  
21 has been released, and the remaining balance of \$16,207,000 of  
22 moneys appropriated is scheduled to lapse on June 30, 2008.



1           The purpose of this part is to reauthorize the  
2 appropriation of funds for the development of Hawaii community  
3 college campuses and west Hawaii campus center projects and to  
4 extend the lapse date.

5           SECTION 5. The director of finance is authorized to issue  
6 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$16,207,000 or so much  
7 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much thereof  
8 as may be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2008-2009  
9 for the purpose of financing capital improvement projects for  
10 the second representative district, as follows:

11 1. To be expended by Hawaii community college  
12 at Hilo:

13           Hawaii community college, Manono  
14           campus, Komohana campus, and west  
15           Hawaii campus center developments,  
16           Hawaii  
17           Plans, design, construction, and  
18           equipment for the development of Hawaii  
19           community college at the Manono campus,  
20           at the Komohana campus situated mauka  
21           of Komohana street, and at west Hawaii  
22           campous center. Projects to include



1 ground and site improvements,  
 2 equipment, and appurtenances, and all  
 3 related project costs.

9 SECTION 6. The sums appropriated for the respective  
 10 capital projects set forth in section 4 shall be expended by the  
 11 designated expending agency for the purposes of this part.

12 SECTION 7. The appropriation made for the capital  
 13 improvement project authorized by this part shall not lapse at  
 14 the end of the fiscal biennium for which the appropriation is  
 15 made; provided that all moneys from the appropriation  
 16 unencumbered as of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as of that date.

17 SECTION 8. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2008.
