## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:**

1           SECTION 1. Section 291C-123, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is  
2 amended to read as follows:

3           "**§291C-123 Driving or parking upon bikeway[-]; parking**  
4 **penalty.** (a) No person shall drive any vehicle other than a  
5 bicycle or moped upon a bicycle lane or bicycle path, except  
6 upon a permanent or authorized temporary driveway, or shall park  
7 any vehicle upon a bicycle lane or bicycle path; provided that  
8 any vehicle may be driven or parked in a bicycle lane or bicycle  
9 path as applicable if:

10           (1) It is in the process of executing a legal turn, lane  
11 change, or parking maneuver;

12           (2) It is an authorized emergency vehicle performing the  
13 functions under section 291C-26;

14           (3) It is an official federal, state, or county vehicle in  
15 the performance of its actual duty;

16           (4) It is a stalled or broken vehicle;

17           (5) It is necessary to assist a stalled or broken vehicle;



1 (6) It is necessary to yield to an authorized emergency  
2 vehicle pursuant to section 291C-65; or

3 (7) It is otherwise provided by law.

4 (b) Any person violating the parking provision provided  
5 for in subsection (a) shall be fined not more than \$500."

6 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed  
7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.



**Report Title:**

Bikeways; Parking.

**Description:**

Prohibits parking of motor vehicles on bicycle lanes or bicycle paths. Assesses up to \$500 fine per violation. (HB3249 HD1)
