A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ISSUANCE OF SPECIAL PURPOSE REVENUE BONDS TO ASSIST SOPOGY INC., IN THE DEVELOPMENT OF RENEWABLE ENERGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the development of clean electricity from a renewable and abundant resource, the 2 sun, at a price lower than the market price and independent from 3 oil price fluctuations is in the best interests of the public. 4 5 Sopogy, Inc., specializes in the development, manufacture, and distribution of its proprietary concentrated solar power systems 6 that generate electricity. The legislature finds that the 7 8 construction of a solar farm power plant that Sopogy, Inc., 9 seeks to create at the natural energy laboratory of Hawaii 10 authority site or at other suitable sites in Hawaii would demonstrate how electricity could be produced by using solar 11 12 power systems.

For the foregoing reasons, the legislature finds and declares that the issuance of special purpose revenue bonds under this Act is in the public interest and is beneficial to the public health, safety, and general welfare.

The legislature further finds that part V, chapter 39A, 1 Hawaii Revised Statutes, permits the State to financially assist 2 industrial enterprises through the issuance of special purpose 3 revenue bonds and that the issuance of special purpose revenue 4 5 bonds under this Act is in the public interest and for the public health, safety, and general welfare of the State. The 6 legislature finds that Sopogy, Inc., is an industrial enterprise 7 8 meeting the qualifications for special purpose revenue bond assistance under part V, chapter 39A, Hawaii Revised Statutes. 9 The special purpose revenue bonds authorized under this Act will 10 provide low interest rate bond financing for the construction of 11 12 a solar farm power plant at the natural energy laboratory of 13 Hawaii authority site or at other suitable sites in Hawaii. 14 SECTION 2. Pursuant to part V, chapter 39A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the department of budget and finance, with the 15 approval of the governor, is authorized to issue special purpose 16 revenue bonds in a total amount not to exceed \$10,000,000 in one 17 or more series, for the purpose of assisting Sopogy, Inc., with 18

The legislature hereby finds and determines that the
 proposed activity and facilities of Sopogy, Inc., constitute a
 project as defined in part V, chapter 39A, Hawaii Revised
 Statutes, and the financing thereof is assistance to an
 industrial enterprise.

6 SECTION 3. The special purpose revenue bonds and the 7 refunding special purpose revenue bonds issued under this Act 8 shall be issued pursuant to part V, chapter 39A, Hawaii Revised 9 Statutes, relating to the power to issue special purpose revenue 10 bonds to assist industrial enterprises.

SECTION 4. The department of budget and finance is 11 12 authorized, from time to time, including times subsequent to June 30, 2012, to issue special purpose revenue bonds in 13 14 whatever principal amounts the department shall determine to be necessary to refund the special purpose revenue bonds authorized 15 16 in section 2 and any refunding of special purpose revenue bonds authorized in this section, regardless of whether the 17 outstanding special purpose revenue bonds or refunding special 18 purpose revenue bonds have matured or are the subject of 19 20 redemption or whether the refunding special purpose revenue bonds shall be bonds for the multi-project programs described in 21 In making this determination, the department shall 22 section 2.

 SECTION 5. The authorization to issue special purpose
 revenue bonds under this Act shall lapse on June 30, 2012.
 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
