
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE UNIVERSITY OF HAWAII.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that, while there is much
2 to be proud of in this centennial year of the University of
3 Hawaii, there is also much more that needs to be done to
4 recognize the University of Hawaii's many opportunities and
5 successes. For example, the people of Hawaii have displayed
6 tremendous support and loyalty to the University of Hawaii
7 athletics program, which has been a source of great pride and
8 inspiration for our entire State, much as professional teams are
9 for other cities and states. With the significant achievements
10 of the University of Hawaii Warrior football team, the
11 University of Hawaii must move forward, especially in the areas
12 of facilities renewal, revenue generation, and compensation.

13 The legislature also finds that leveraging the University
14 of Hawaii's successes will require focused priorities and
15 consistent efforts to improve facilities throughout the ten-
16 campus University of Hawaii system. The \$50,000,000 requested
17 by the governor's office for the University of Hawaii system
18 repair and maintenance must be increased to \$100,000,000. This



1 is an appropriate way to honor the University of Hawaii's first
 2 one hundred years, and will also allow for the university
 3 administration to address much of its facility needs for
 4 academics and athletics. In the area of athletics, a
 5 comprehensive approach is needed to ensure that the University
 6 of Hawaii is able to bring a brighter and more productive second
 7 century of opportunities and successes to the people of Hawaii.

8 The purpose of this Act is to honor the accomplishments of
 9 the University of Hawaii and make a financial commitment to its
 10 continued success in the coming century of its founding.

11 SECTION 2. The director of finance is authorized to issue
 12 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$100,000,000 or so much
 13 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum is appropriated for
 14 fiscal year 2008-2009 for capital renewal and deferred
 15 maintenance items, to be distributed as follows:

16	University of Hawaii system	\$ 1,500,000
17	University of Hawaii at Hilo	16,500,000
18	University of Hawaii at West Oahu	300,000
19	University of Hawaii Community Colleges	31,500,000
20	University of Hawaii at Manoa	50,200,000
21	Total funding:	\$100,000,000



1 Of the amounts appropriated for the University of Hawaii at
 2 Manoa, \$11,750,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary,
 3 shall be dedicated to the following capital improvement
 4 projects:

5	Cooke field, replacement	\$ 1,500,000
6	Cooke field, bleacher replacement	500,000
7	Les Murakami stadium, renovations	2,300,000
8	Stan Sheriff center, renovations	750,000
9	Gym I and gym II, renovations	750,000
10	Lower campus road, resurfacing	350,000
11	Health, physical education, and	
12	recreation classrooms, renovations	5,000,000
13	Coaches offices, renovations	100,000
14	Duke Kahanamoku aquatic center, renovations	500,000

15 SECTION 3. The director of finance is authorized to issue
 16 general obligation bonds in the sum of \$13,250,000 or so much
 17 thereof as may be necessary and the same sum or so much as may
 18 be necessary is appropriated for fiscal year 2008-2009 for the
 19 following capital improvement projects:

20	Women's locker rooms, improvements and	
21	for Title IX compliance	3,200,000
22	Men's locker rooms, improvements	1,000,000



1	Master plan for lower campus	750,000
2	Cooke field, mauka structure and seats	5,000,000
3	Cooke field, mauka restrooms	
4	and locker rooms	2,300,000
5	Softball stadium, improvements	1,000,000

6 SECTION 4. The appropriations made for the capital
7 improvement projects authorized in sections 2 and 3 of this Act
8 shall not lapse at the end of the fiscal biennium for which the
9 appropriation is made; provided that all appropriations which
10 are unencumbered as of June 30, 2010, shall lapse as of that
11 date.
