## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURE

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that chapter 180, Hawaii
- 2 Revised Statutes, allowed for the establishment of soil and
- 3 water conservation districts as subdivisions of the State to
- 4 act, educate, construct, maintain, and assist in the development
- 5 of conservation plans and oversee county grading ordinances.
- **6** The first soil and water conservation district was
- 7 established on the island of Maui in 1948, to assist Kula
- 8 farmers. Since then fifteen other districts have been
- 9 established, each with up to five board members and any number
- 10 of associate, nonvoting board members. All board members are
- 11 nonpaid volunteers serving two year terms.
- 12 Together the sixteen soil and water conservation districts
- 13 form the Hawaii Association of Conservation Districts.
- 14 The purpose of this Act is to make an appropriation to fund
- 15 the Hawaii Association of Conservation Districts in its
- 16 operational expenses for all of its soil and water conservation
- 17 districts.

- 1 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$500,000, or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2007-2008, and the
- 4 same sum, or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 5 2008-2009, for the Hawaii Association of Conservation Districts
- 6 for the operation of the soil and water conservation districts.
- 7 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 8 of land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.

9 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2007.
