# A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PSYCHOTROPIC MEDICATION.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Section 346-59.9, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is		
2	amended to read as follows:		
3	"[ <b>+</b> ] <b>§346-59.9[+] Psychotropic medication.</b> (a) The		
4	department shall not impose any restriction or limitation on the		
5	coverage for, or a recipient's access to, psychotropic		
6	medication; provided that the psychotropic medication shall be		
7	prescribed by a [ <del>licensed</del> ] psychiatrist [ <del>or by a</del> ], physician, or		
8	an advanced practice registered nurse who has entered into a		
9	collegial relationship with a psychiatrist or physician, duly		
10	licensed in the State.		
11	(b) The department shall report to the legislature no		
12	later than twenty days before the convening of each regular		
13	session on:		
14	(1) The number of prescriptions written pursuant to this		
15	section;		
16	(2) The cost and impact of psychiatrists, physicians, or		
17	advanced practice nurses prescribing medications,		



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1	pursuant to this section, that are not part of the			
2	existing formulary; and			
3	(3) The overall use of psychotropic medication under			
4	chapter 346.			
5	[ <del>(b)</del> ] <u>(c)</u> As used in this section[+			
6	"Psychotropic medication"], "psychotropic medication" means			
7	only those agents approved by the United States Food and Drug			
8	Administration for the treatment of mental or emotional			
9	disorders."
