### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO MOTOR SPORTS FACILITY.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

The legislature finds that the erstwhile motor SECTION 1. 1 sports facility in leeward Oahu allowed motor vehicles to 2 compete in motor sports under safe conditions and provided a 3 vital service to the community by keeping motor racing and all 4 of its inherent dangers off the public streets and freeways. A 5 motor sports facility can also be a benefit to public safety by 6 providing a place to safely train law enforcement personnel from 7 the State and the counties, as well as the general public, in 8 the safe handling of motor vehicles. 9

10 The purpose of this Act is to determine the cost of11 developing and operating a new motor sports facility on Oahu.

SECTION 2. (a) The department of accounting and general services shall conduct a study to determine the cost of developing an all-purpose motor sports facility on Oahu, including acquisition of land, construction, and costs of startup, maintenance, and operation.

17 (b) The department shall consider at least the following18 cost factors:



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1	(1)	Acquisition of adequate land by purchase, lease,
2		exchange, or any other appropriate means, including
3		financing;
4	(2)	Planning, design, and construction of the facility,
5		including:
6		(A) Multi-purpose driving surfaces, barriers,
7		fencing, lighting, and driver communication
8		systems;
9		(B) Training and educational facilities, including
10		classrooms;
11		(C) Safety and first response medical facility and
12		safety containment systems;
13		(D) Participant and spectator accommodations,
14		including maintenance, security, storage, and
15		other supporting facilities; and
16		(E) Equipment intended for permanent use in the
17		facility.
18	(3)	Initial costs of start-up, if any;
19	(4)	Routine maintenance of the facility for the first ten
20		years; and
21	(5)	Routine operating costs, taking into account any fees
22		that may be charged to users of the facility.



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1	(c) The department shall submit a written final report to
2	the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening
3	of the regular session of 2008.

4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2025.
