
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ENERGY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 196-18, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:

3 "(b) The committee shall provide input on state energy
4 management, including how to:

5 (1) Improve the use of energy-savings contracts;

6 (2) Improve procurement of ENERGY STAR and other energy
7 efficient products;

8 (3) Improve building design;

9 (4) Reduce energy use;

10 (5) Enhance applications of efficient and renewable energy
11 technologies at state facilities;

12 (6) Establish benchmarks and evaluate the State's progress
13 in incorporating energy efficiency and conservation
14 for state facilities, vehicles, and equipment;

15 (7) Make recommendations on how and when to conduct
16 periodic energy audits; and

17 (8) Make recommendations to the legislature no later than
18 twenty days prior to the convening of each even-



1 numbered regular session, starting with the [2008]
2 2010 regular session, regarding policy or other
3 statutory changes to carry out the purposes of this
4 chapter."

5 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Energy; Public-Private Advisory Committee

Description:

Changes the frequency with which the energy resources public-private advisory committee is required to report to the legislature from annual to biennial (even-numbered years only), beginning with the 2010 regular session. (HB647 HD1)
