A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WAIVER OF ABANDONED VEHICLE PUBLIC AUCTION REQUIREMENTS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 290-5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
amended to read as follows:
"§290-5 Waiver of public auction requirements. The
requirements of public auction may be waived when the value of
any vehicle is less than \$1,000 as determined by the director of

6 finance or authorized representative [-] or the vehicle is:

7

(1) Missing major components or so materially damaged as

8

to render the vehicle inoperable; and

9 (2) The registration period has expired for the vehicle. 10 In that event, the vehicle, after public advertisement has been 11 made pursuant to section 1-28.5, may be disposed of in the same 12 manner as when a vehicle is put up for public auction and for 13 which no bid is received."

14 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 15 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

16 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.

Waiver of Abandoned Vehicle Public Auction Requirements

Description:

Allows the waiver of public auction of a towed vehicle that has not been claimed and the vehicle is missing major components or is so materially damaged as to render the vehicle inoperable and the registration period has expired for the vehicle. (HB657 HD1)
