
A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PROPERTY DAMAGE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 708-823.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2 amended by amending subsection (1) to read as follows:

3 "(1) A person commits the offense of aggravated criminal
4 property damage if the person by means other than fire:

5 (a) Intentionally damages the property of another without
6 the other's consent; and

7 (b) Has been convicted two or more times of an offense
8 under section 708-822 or 708-823 [~~in the preceding~~
9 ~~five years~~]."

10 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
11 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
12 begun, before its effective date.

13 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
14 and stricken.

15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
